TENDER NOTICE

National Institute of Oceanography (NIO), Karachi, Pakistan, working under the Ministry of Science & Technology, Government of Pakistan invites bids through E-Pak Acquisition and Disposal System (ePADS) from the manufacturer / authorized dealer / authorized agents registered with Income Tax, Sales Tax and Sindh Sales Tax / Revenue Board (Provincial, for services) Departments for the **Procurement of Physical Instruments and Hydrodynamic Modeling and Graphing Software** under PSDP Project, Monitoring the Sea Water Intrusion, Sea Level Rise, Coastal Erosion & Land Subsidence along Sindh and Balochistan Coast for the Financial Year 2025-26.

The interested bidders can obtain bidding document, containing detailed terms and conditions, bid security, bid validity, opening of bid, evaluation criteria, clarification / rejection of bids, performance guarantee etc., from <https://eprocare.gov.pk>, bidding document can also be seen and downloaded from the NIO website (www.niopk.gov.pk). Bids should be submitted electronically through EPADS for the evaluation.

The bids, prepared in accordance with the instructions in the bidding documents, must be submitted on EPADS by **25th November, 2025** (Tuesday) at **1200 hrs**. Bids will be opened on the same day at **1230 hrs** through EPADS.

Each bid must include a **bid security equal to 2% of the total contract value** (as per Clause IT.13) in the form of a pay order, demand draft, or call deposit in favour of the National Institute of Oceanography (NIO). A **non-refundable tender fee of Rs.500 (cash)** and the **bid security** must accompany sealed, signed, and stamped bids, which should be submitted to the undersigned's office by **24th November, 2025**. Bids without the required bid security or tender fee will not be accepted.

Rates must be inclusive of GST and other Taxes/duties (if any) as levied from time to time by the Federal Government. In case the day of bid opening falls on a public/local holiday, next working day shall be considered as the deadline for the same. The bid opening procedure is single stage two enveloping procedure Rule 36(b) of Public Procurement Rules, 2004. This advertisement is also available on PPRA website (www.ppra.org.pk).
